POLICY – GUIDELINES NO. 71 – 2015

Reduction of Tuition Fee for the Diploma in Midwifery program at IFSU Potia Campus from PhP275.00/unit to PhP150.00/unit effective 1st Semester S.Y. 2015-2016

I. RATIONALE

The offering of the ladderized Diploma in Midwifery program at IFSU Potia Campus started in June 2008 as a special program which was duly approved by the Board of Trustees of then Ifugao State College of Agriculture and Forestry (ISCAF) as per Resolution No. 909, s. 2008. As a special program at that time, the tuition fee was set at PhP275.00/unit, enough to finance its operation due to small number of perceived enrollees as per survey results.

However, with the increased enrollment in previous years, the program is proven to be financially self-sustaining. Along with the clamor of students and their parents, the Academic Council Members at IFSU Potia Campus presented a feasibility study and proposal to the Administrative Council of the University wherein lowering the tuition fee of the program from PhP275.00/unit to PhP150.00/unit could still sustain its operation. Also, the Diploma in Midwifery offered at IFSU Main Campus is collecting PhP150.00/unit to its students. Thus, with the aim of standardizing tuition fees for all University-wide programs, the proposal of PhP150.00/unit for the Diploma in Midwifery at IFSU Potia Campus was approved/endorsed by the Administrative Council last April 8, 2015 and approved by the Board of Regents on July 10, 2015 as per Resolution No. 484, s. 2015.

II. POLICY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The tuition fee for the Diploma in Midwifery at IFSU Potia Campus shall now be One Hundred Fifty Pesos per unit (PhP150.00/unit) to be applicable for all students duly enrolled in the program including transferees.
2. There shall be no increase/decrease in Related Learning Experiences (RLE) fee to sustain procurement of necessary medical equipment, instructional supplies, and salaries of Clinical Instructors.
3. All other University fees duly approved by the Board of Regents shall be collected to all students. Student scholars shall be exempted from paying the University fees provided the granting institution/individual shall shoulder the fees at the expense of the scholars.
4. Previous issuances of the University regarding tuition fee of the Diploma in Midwifery program at IFSU Potia Campus are hereby repealed.
