POLICY – GUIDELINES NO. 72 – 2015

Increase of Campus Student Supreme Government or CSSG Fee to One Hundred Pesos (PhP100.00) effective 1st Semester S.Y. 2015-2016

I. RATIONALE

Originally, the CSSG is defined as College Student Supreme Government with a corresponding fee of PhP50.00 and to be collected per undergraduate student as per BOT Resolution No. 795, s. 2005. However, with the change in nomenclature, it was amended by the students and their officers to Campus Student Supreme Government in 2015 to differentiate it with the University Student Supreme Government (USSG). CSSG is the highest governing student body in the campus while the USSG is the highest governing student body in the whole university. All student officers of CSSG from all the campuses of Ifugao State University (IFSU) shall form a federation and elect its officers who shall sit and manage the affairs of the USSG. The USSG President shall be representing the whole students in the IFSU Board of Regents.

Along with the amendments is the increase of CSSG Fee from PhP50.00 to PhP100.00 with the aim of delivering better services to its stakeholders. With the aim of delivering impactful outputs benefiting the whole university, it was agreed by the members and officers of both organizations that Twenty Percent (20%) of PhP100.00 shall be used as fund of the USSG organization. Series of consultations and surveys were held to be able to obtain majority consensus from the members of the organization. With positive survey results and good convictions for the purposes of the proposal, the amendments were approved by the IFSU Board of Regents as per Resolution No. 485, s. 2015.

II. POLICY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Each undergraduate student shall pay the new CSSG fee amounting to One Hundred Pesos (PhP100.00) upon enrollment per semester at the designated Cashier Section of the University. An official receipt from the University shall be issued upon payment.
2. Twenty Percent (20%) of the amount shall be used as fund for the University Student Supreme Government (USSG) while the remaining Eighty Percent (80%) shall be the fund for the Campus Student Supreme Government (CSSG) of the campus concerned.
3. In accordance with the Constitution and by-laws of both student organizations, the CSSG and USSG shall strive to achieve the following objectives, to wit:
 - a. Effectively deliver and sustain the programs, projects, activities, services, and policies for the students to be fully empowered to collaborate for the achievement of IFSU's vision for academic excellence;
 - b. Address students/college organizations' request for programs, projects, activities, services, and provide additional financial support for regional, national, and international competitions;
 - c. Allocate a portion of the fund as service scholarship for both CSSG and USSG officers; and

- d. Strive to be a self-sufficient student organization while keeping at pace with effectivity and productivity.
4. Previous issuances of the University regarding CSSG fee are hereby repealed.
