In accordance with the pertinent provisions of Republic Act (RA) No. 7722, otherwise known as the "Higher Education Act of 1994", all Directors and Officers-In-Charge of CHED Regional Offices and Presidents of State Universities and Colleges are hereby informed that there are reports being received by the Commission that some State Universities and Colleges (SUCs) are asking the potential ESGP-PA students-grantees for entrance examination fee.

In this connection, all concerned are hereby reminded that per Joint Memorandum Order No. 2014-1 "Guidelines on the Implementation of Expanded Students' Grants-In-Aid Program for Poverty Alleviation (ESGP-PA)", SUCs are supposed to 'administer flexible admission policies at **no cost** to students'. Potential student-grantees should in no case pay for the admission process.

Said provision is in support with the main objective of the ESGP-PA to contribute to the National Government's thrusts in effectively addressing poverty alleviation by increasing the number of graduates in higher education among poor households in order to lift their families out of poverty and contribute to national development.
