SUBJECT : CREATION OF THE COLLEGE OF CRIMINOLOGY (CC) AND SEPARATING IT FROM THE COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCES (CAS)

DATE : JUNE 17, 2013

1. In relation to the 1st and 5th Development Goals which is the pursuit of excellence in instruction and excellence in administration & governance and having complied with the provisions set in the University Code as per Section 3.1. IFSU Organizational Structure, a College of Criminology is hereby created to be composed of the following programs, to wit:
 - 1.a. Master of Science in Criminal Justice *with specialization in Criminology*;
 - 1.b. Bachelor of Science in Criminology;
 - 1.c. Diploma in Security Services

** As of 1st Semester SY 2013-2014, a total of 773 students are enrolled in the CC programs.*
2. The College of Arts and Sciences shall henceforth be composed of the following programs, to wit:
 - 2.a. Bachelor of Arts (Tourism);
 - 2.b. Bachelor of Arts (Political Science);
 - 2.c. Bachelor of Science in Mathematics;
 - 2.d. Bachelor of Science in Psychology (approved for offering effective SY 2014-2015).

*** As of 1st Semester SY 2013-2014, a total of 356 students are enrolled in the CAS Programs.*
3. The College of Criminology shall occupy, manage and develop the area/ building along the ridge boundary of the university land area above the national road (where the Globe mini-tower is) with the college officials holding offices therein;
4. The College of Arts and Sciences shall occupy, manage and develop the area/ building currently being used by the College with the college officials holding offices therein;
5. Faculty members with majority of their teaching loads in any of these colleges shall form part of the core faculty members assigned therein;
6. For the information, commitment and guidance of all.

 - B.S. Bachelor of Science in Psychology (Specialized for offering effective 2017-2018)
 - B.S. Bachelor of Science in Education (Specialized for offering effective 2017-2018)
- The College of Criminology shall occupy, manage and develop the newly building, being the large boundary of the university land and above the national road (where the existing building is) with the college officials holding offices therein.
- The College of Arts and Sciences shall occupy, manage and develop the existing building currently being used by the College with the college officials holding offices therein.
- Faculty members with majority of their teaching loads in any of these colleges shall form part of the core faculty members assigned therein.
